

# ILS completes four years

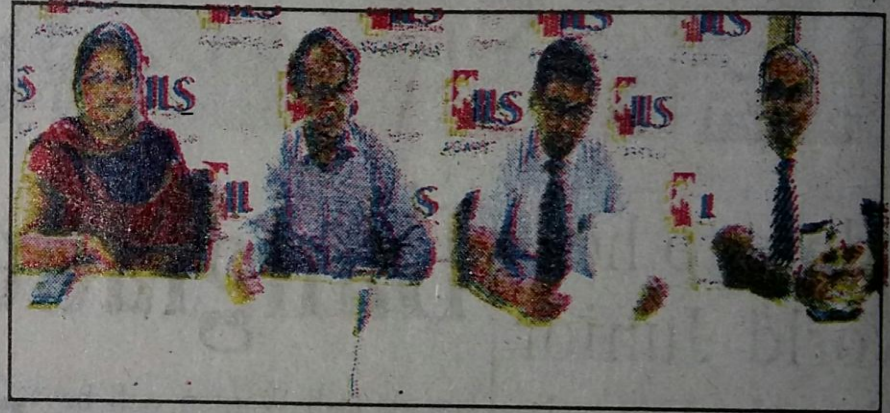

Agartala, Sept 25: ILS Hospital, Agartala is going to complete its fourth years of its journey in the State.

ILS Hospital will complete its fourth year of inauguration on October 2. The Hospital started its journey in the State on October 2, 2011 with the objective of providing healthcare service for the people of the State. During these four years, more than one lakh patients have visited its OPD; around 15,000 patients have been admitted and treated in the hospital. Till now they have done more than 1300 laproscopic surgeries, more than 1000 cardiac patients including angiography and angioplasty.

ILS Hospital also has well equipped ICU to provide 24 hours' critical care. The hospital is running 4 peripheral OPD's in Udaipur, Khowai, Teliamura, Sonamura covering 3 outlying districts. They have plan to set up POPD cum information centers in remaining district head quarters in a phased manner.

Various steps have been taken by the hospital authority to observe completing of its four years. Like previous years, ILS hospital will also observe 'World Heart Day' by organizing a Walk-a-thon. The Walk-a-thon will be held on September 27. It will start from Birendra Club and cover the Paradise

To make the occasion of completing four years, ILS Hospital will be offering subsidized surgery packages for CAG, Angioplasty, Gallbladder stone removal, Appendix Operation, Cesarean etc. This discounted package will be applicable from October 1 to October 3. heart of the city to take the OPD and diagnostic services to the door step of the people.
